


PLANTS FOR STREAMGARDEN



BASIL

Latin name: *Ocimum basilicum*

Sowing: From seed or plant. When sowing seeds, remember that you can have 10-15 basil plants in one pot in the Streamgarden. They get enough water and nutrition and will not compete with each other.

Growing: Basil wants a lot of sun. When the plant starts to bloom, top off all flowers to keep it from getting old too fast. Basil plants age, an old plant tastes less good. Exchange your plants and remember to sow new ones in time.

Eating: Use the basil leaves fresh. Harvest continuously.

THAI BASIL

Eating: For Thai food and wok. Other recommendations same as for normal basil.

PELARGONIUM

Sowing: Take a cutting, buy a pelargonium or ask your grandmother for one. Growing: More sun gives more flowers.

LEMON BALM

Latin name: *Melissa officinalis*

Sowing: From seeds or buy a plant. If the plant is big you can split it. Eating: Harvest continuously. Use it to flavour water. Or for tea, perhaps mixed with mints.

OREGANO

Latin name: *Oreganum vulgare*

Sowing: From seed, plant or cuttings. Eating: Harvest continuously, use on pizza for example.

CHILE PEPPERS

Latin name: *Capsicum annum*

Sowing: From seeds
Growing: Likes a sunny location.
Eating: Use the peppers fresh or dry them to store them. Use in chili, sauces or check out the internet for the many sites with recipes provided by chili heads.

SAGE

Latin name: *Salvia officinalis*.

Sowing: From seeds or cuttings.
Eating: Harvest continuously. The leaves can be dried. Goes well with lamb.

MINTS

Latin name: *Menthae piperitae*

Sowing: From seeds, plant or cuttings.
Growing: Mint likes a sunny location. Look out for plant louse! There is a lot of different hybrids of mint. Try them out!
Eating: Harvest continuously. Use for tea, sauces.

STRAWBERRY

Latin name: *Fragaria x anassa*

Growing. Strawberries give no harvest during their first year. Therefore we recommend that you buy a plant that is ready to give strawberries. There is a lot of different kinds of strawberries that you can try.


WILD STRAWBERRIES

The recommendations are the same as for strawberries.

TOMATOES

Latin name: *Solanum lycopersicum*

Sowing: From seeds or plant.
Growing: Choose a tomato that grows a small plant, otherwise it can be tricky to support it. Anyway you need to support your plant with a cord or similar to keep it from falling.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

The only moving part in the Streamgarden is the pump. We give a 2 year warranty on the pump.

Your Streamgarden contains the following components and materials:

Upper and lower tank in polyethylene, PE.
Outflow pipe in polypropylene, PP.
Inflow tube in polyvinylchlorid, PVC.
Pots in polyethylene, PE.

These parts are recycled as hard plastics.

Filter for circulation pump in polyether foam. Recycled as soft plastics.

Circulation pump model Sicce MiMouse. Effect 3.8 watts. Recycled as electronics.

Nutrition A: Nitrate of lime
Nutrition B: Contains for example potassium, nitrogen, nitrate and tracer elements.

You can of course also use other fertilizers suitable for hydroponics.

Clay pellets: Contains clay.
