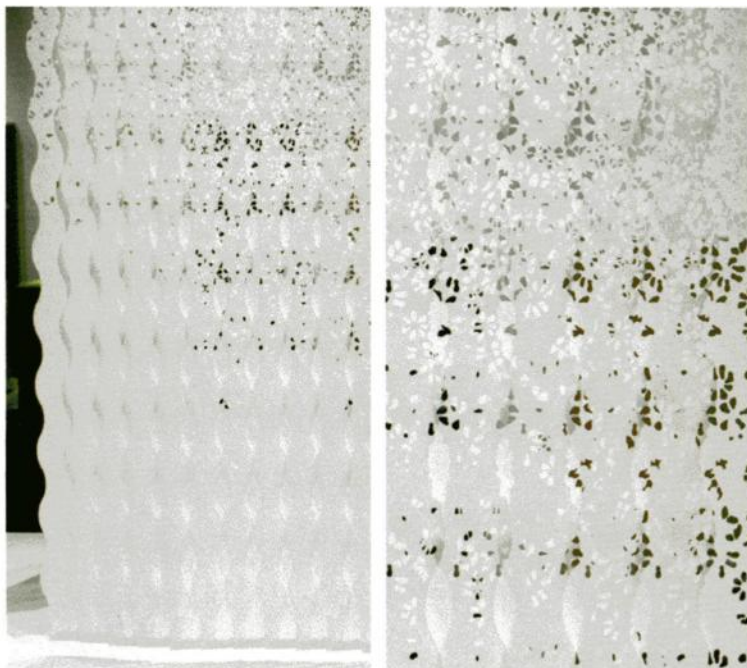

Ever gone on holiday and found your plants or kitchen herbs reduced to straw on return? The Streamgarden might be a solution. Thanks to a NASA-tested technology called hydroponics – cultivation without soil in pure water – plants survive for weeks without watering. The bottom part of the product is filled with water and nutrients and connected to a circulation pump; the top part contains planting pots.
